

Be on the lookout for more information to come home in the next couple of weeks.</p>	<p><u>2010 U.S. CENSUS</u> Beginning April 1, 2010, the United States will undergo a comprehensive census of everyone living in the country. The census takes place every 10 years and is designed to collect population information in order that federal and state resources can be distributed to areas of the country based on the needs of the people living in those areas. The census plays an important role in schools because data collected is used to distribute funding and other resources needed to serve our students. Clovis Unified annually receives more than \$3 million to provide targeted services to our students based on census data. Information collected through the U.S. Census is also used to decide how much money California will get for neighborhood improvements, public health, transportation, and many other programs and services. It is important that every family in Clovis Unified complete the census, and that information about every child living in a household is included in the census count, regardless of his or her age.
